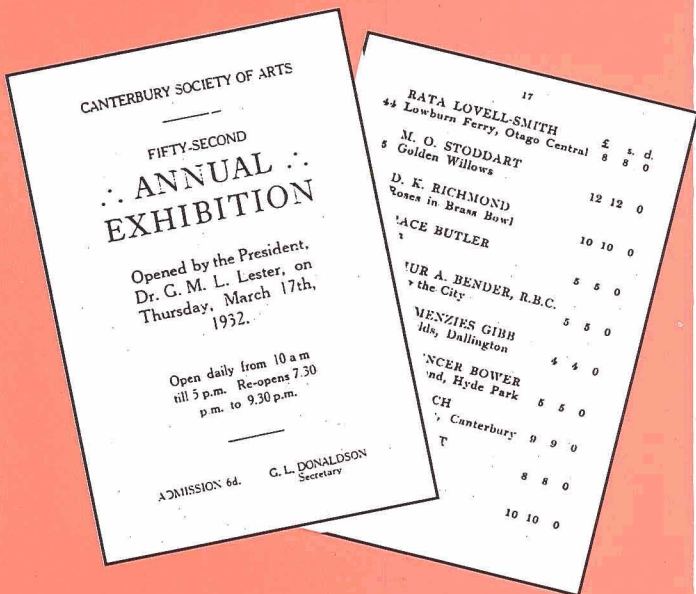

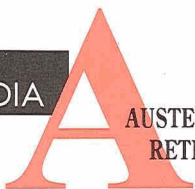

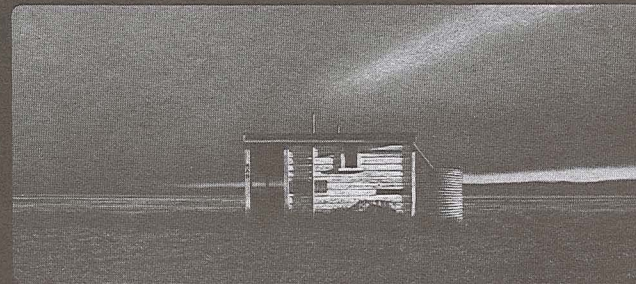

#### FOUNDATIONS FOUND-NATIONS

Greg Cooper is a graduate of Ilam School of Fine Arts. He is a painter. For the past two years he has focused on semi-abstract paintings.

His painting reflects an interest in corrosive rustic and weathered surfaces, and the works explore different mark-making and texture—reflecting the organic or man-made nature of those surfaces.

They are primarily tonal works using subtle earthy colours. Works on canvas are supported by drawings and small studies on paper.

Since living in Hawkes Bay, Greg has had a solo exhibition, works exhibited in the Telecom Regional finals, and in the 1993 HB Review in Napier.
