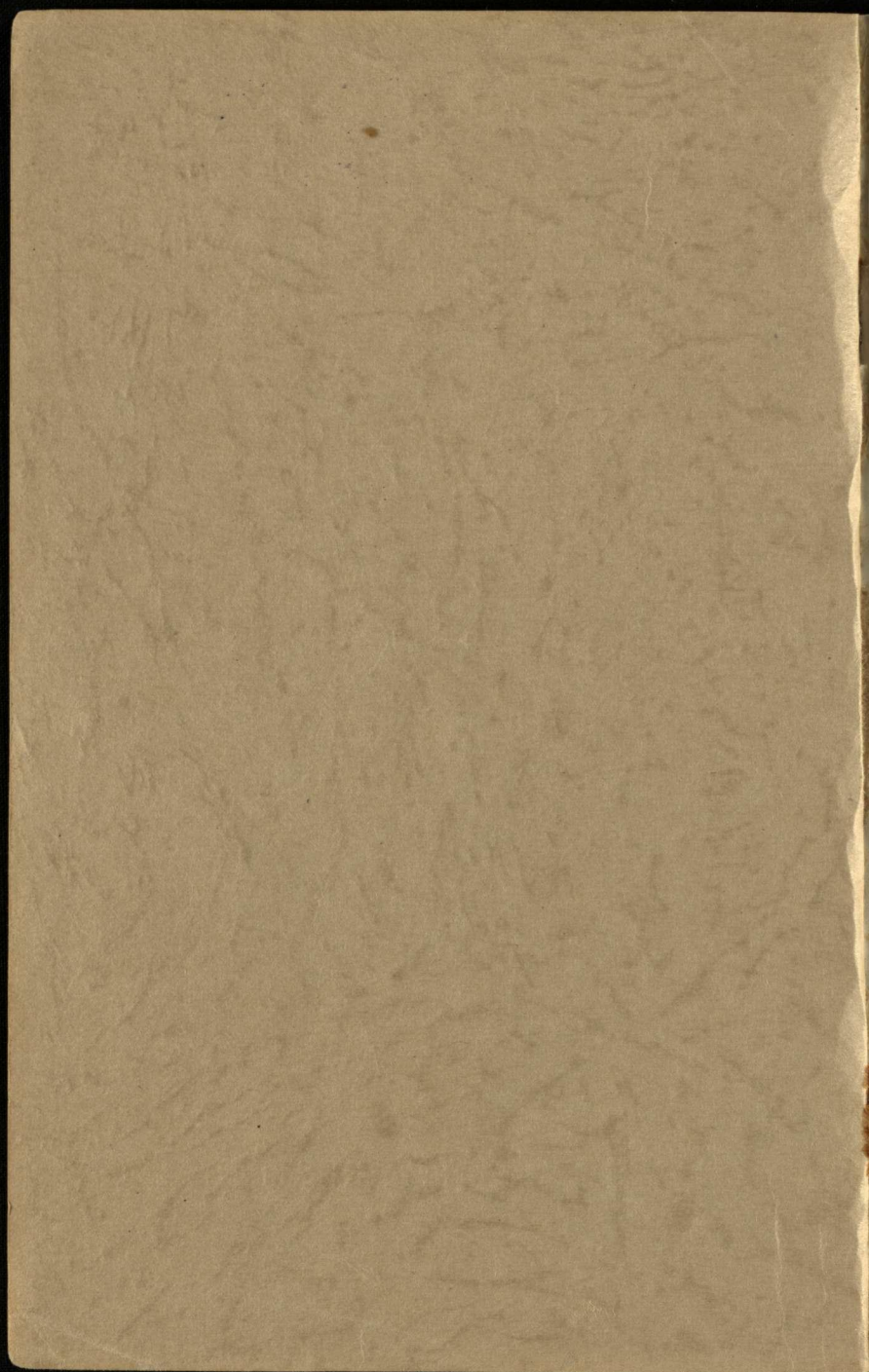

## Short History of the Society

---

The Canterbury Society of Arts was formed on July 8th, 1880. In 1889 the Society was registered under the Companies Act, 1882. By special Act of Parliament a site for the present Gallery was granted by the Government. In 1890 the Permanent Gallery was built, and on the 13th of January, 1891, the Annual Meeting of Members was held in the new building. Later on, it was found necessary to extend the building by widening the Armagh Street frontage, and the Government made a further grant of land, which necessitated removing part of the Immigration Office which was then situated where the Magistrate's Court now stands. In 1894 additions were made to the building.

In 1932, on the completion of the Building of the Robert McDougall Art Gallery, the Society presented the best of its collection of paintings, etc., to the City and this collection is now in that Gallery. In 1938, the New Zealand Government asked the Society to relinquish its present property for the purpose of building a new Supreme Court, the condition being that they replace the Gallery with a new building on a suitable site. This was agreed to and plans have been approved; but owing to the outbreak of war last year, the transfer is being held in abeyance.

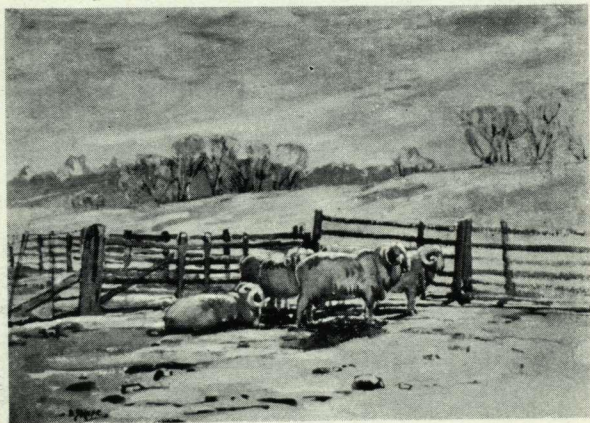

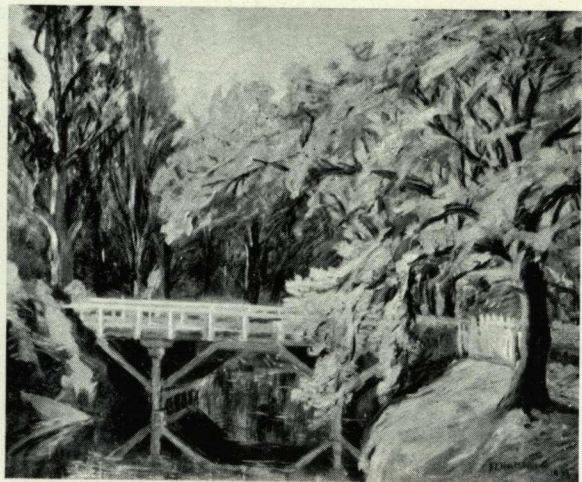

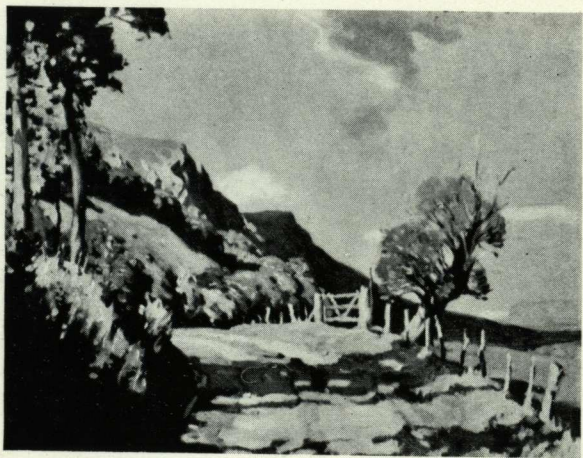
