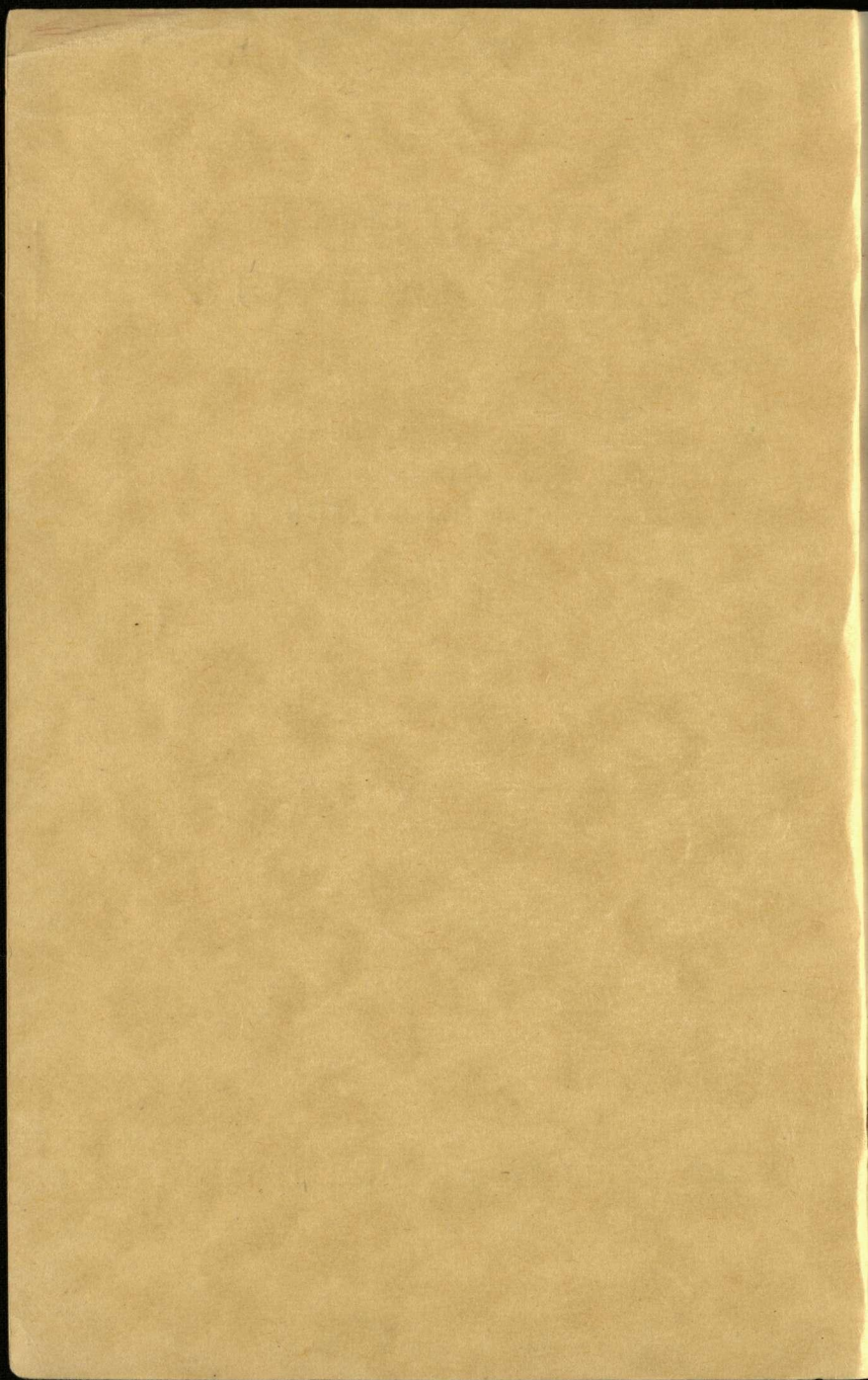

The Canterbury Society of Arts

The Society is so inadequately provided with funds for the purchase of pictures that the Council desires again to draw the attention of its friends to the fact that they could greatly assist the function of the Society if they were to give a legacy to the Canterbury Society of Arts.

With the exception of the income from the Bowker Bequest of £500 and the George Jameson Bequest of £50, the only funds available for the purchase of pictures are those occasional surpluses resulting from the economical running of the Society.

To achieve these economies, your Council is handicapped in its desire to further the promotion of art in other directions and now aims at building up a substantial fund for the purchase of pictures. In making this appeal we desire to draw your attention to the large funds available for similar purposes in other New Zealand centres and trust that, knowing the need, lovers of Art in Canterbury will no longer forget us.
