Judge's Remarks

Art Competitions can serve a useful purpose in the community. Provided an objective attitude is maintained, it gives artists a chance to critically assess their own achievements in relation to the work of other painters. It gives the public a chance to see a great gathering of pictures, to observe various interpretations of our familiar environment, to see that painting is a full form of communication, that some artists are concerned only with the formal elements of painting, whilst others are more interested in visual phenomena and recording the effects of nature.

It has been my task to gather the paintings into the various groupings, then to make judgment on how well the artists and print makers have handled the basic elements of their art. The main elements are line, form, shape, space, colour, texture. It should be the aim of the artist to orchestrate these elements into an effective result. To a great extent, this can be assessed independently of whether the artist is interested in a realistic portrayal or an abstraction.

The Hay's Competition is now an Exhibition of national importance. We congratulate the successful artists and hope that those who did not qualify will accept the judgment in the true spirit of a competition.
