FOREWORD

The annual recurrence of an exhibition of this sort on a national basis is an event of more than obvious significance. The material progress of our times and the educational changes which have accompanied it, do not rest entirely on the credit side of man's cultural balance sheet. The spread of literacy alone has negative aspects not always appreciated, and the super-abundance of "hardware" at the disposal of a modern community has become conspicuously devoid of those signs of man's creative exuberance which are characteristic of the artifacts of more primitive societies. Old class divisions have been erased only to be replaced by entirely new ones and universal literacy in a century has had the effect of creaming off from the artisan world a "leaven" of the gifted and intelligent into academic, scientific and other categories, many of which are unrewarding in a deeper sense, and create a craving for foolish status symbols. Art has become exclusive — a thing of coteries, and men are classified as highbrow and lowbrow, but to an integrated personality the subtle, the sensitive, the elemental, and even the banal all have their time and place. In Shakespeare's day the comedian shared the stage with the actor, and the intellectual shared the auditorium with the artisan. Now we have theatre for highbrows and variety for lowbrows, and popular culture is at the low level at which we now see it.

The astonishing growth of interest in the craft of pottery in New Zealand in only one decade seems like a pointer, and it could well be that we are witnessing signs of incipient change of significance. This growth includes professional and amateur potters, and an immense lay following. In the professional category there are, as in other countries too, conspicuous instances of the return of men and women of graduate calibre to the sphere of artisan endeavour. This return of the "leaven" is a trend which may well become a thing of tremendous cultural importance if the mundane environmental needs of daily life are not by-passed in the process. On the amateur level the participation is on an astonishing scale, and must be one of the most outstanding instances of valid art appreciation today, for to draw, to play a musical instrument, or to make a pot, no matter how inadequately, is an experience vastly more capable of heightening awareness and understanding than the total reliance on the vicarious experiences which our technological society tends to offer as an alternative.

For countless generations the satisfaction of being able visibly to control with one's own hands the transformation of primary materials into useful and beautiful things has been a common creative experience, so that to give it expression has become a deep-seated psychological need. Modern society, which is almost to say urban society, obsessed with the advantages of large scale organization tends to deprive the individual of such creative experiences. It is claimed that this is in the interests of material progress, but there are signs of a growing awareness that society does this at its spiritual and psychological peril.
