SELECTORS' COMMENT

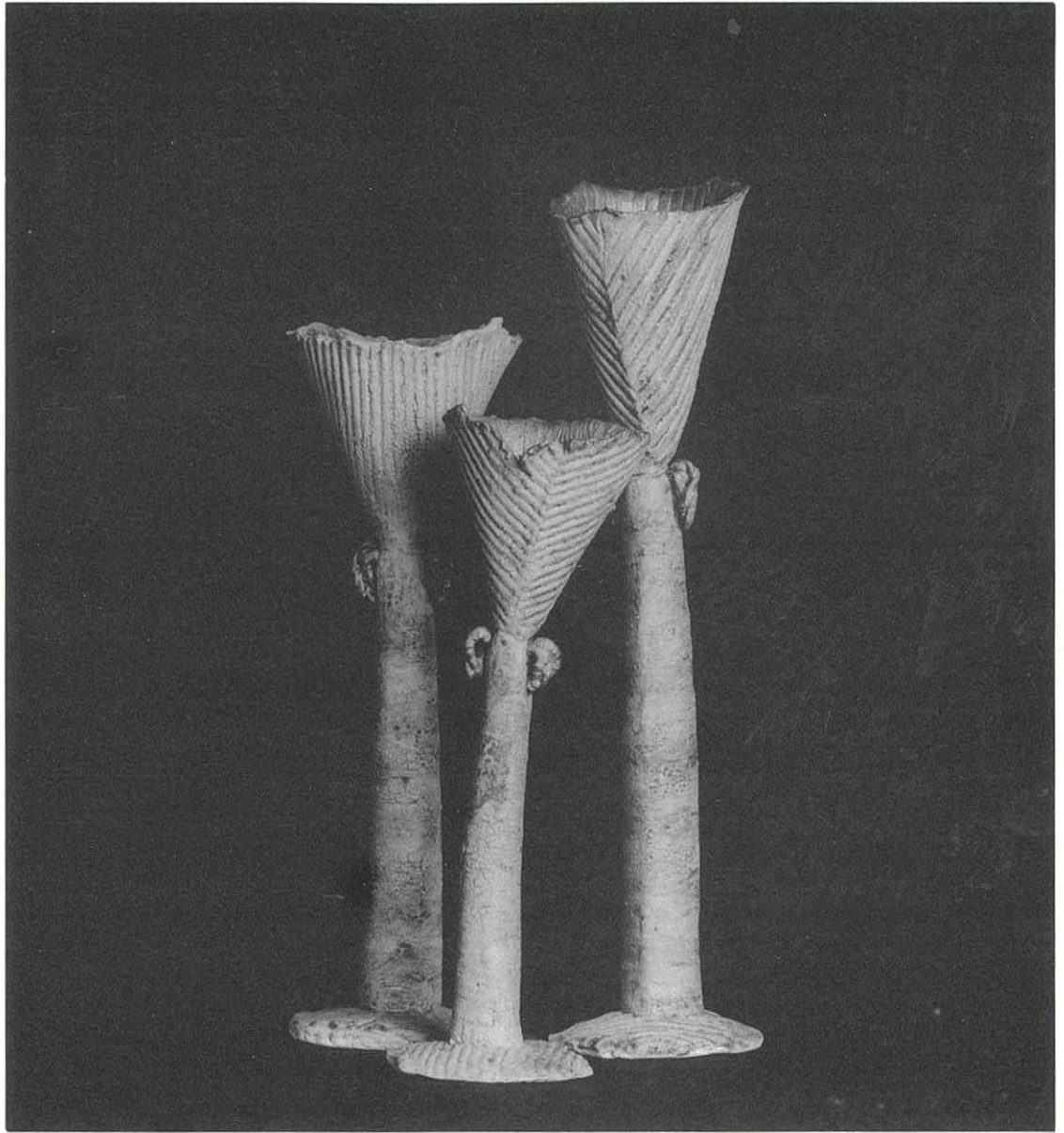
